PANDA MOUNTAIN

Panda Mountain is a conservation and community development organization dedicated to restoring panda habitats. Located in the heart of Wolong Nature Reserve, the organization provides opportunities for people to get involved with restoration and participate in practical hands-on activities to restore degraded habitats and biodiversity.

Marc Brody, advisor to Wolong Administration, President and Founder of Panda Mountain, has designed and managed a wide range of environmental programs in China for over 20 years. In 2008 Marc founded Panda Mountain and was appointed as Wolong's senior advisor for conservation and sustainable development. He is a National Geographic Society grantee. Marc has prepared an exhibition for panda habitat and indigenous communities in the Wolong Nature Reserve and designed a small restoration nursery in the resort. This nursery plot is a place for guests to learn about habitat field work.

PANDA VALLEY ADVENTURE Want to learn more about pandas?

Dujiangyan Panda Valley, or Dujiangyan Research Centerof Giant Panda Breeding, is a new giant panda breeding base. The facility contains three areas which are dedicated to breeding, semiwild reintroduction and full reintroduction.

Currently there are 10 giant pandas in the Center and will be home to 30 to 40 giant pandas, 50 to 100 baby pandas and other wild animals.
